

FLAGSTAFF AREA AND HOTEL INFORMATION

Flagstaff has lots of hotels, but we always advise to make reservations in advance as Flagstaff often has festivals or college events and some of the hotels do get booked to capacity. Also, some hotels give you better prices the earlier you sign-up.

DOWNTOWN AREA

If you want to stay downtown and get a taste of the local life, there are plenty of pubs, restaurants, coffee shops, and tourist and camping/gear shops. The “downtown proper” area is between S. Milton/N. Sitgreaves and Agassiz St. (East/West) and Cherry Ave. and W. Butler (North/South). There are two Hotels downtown (**Monte Vista & The Weatherford**) as well as a Hostel (**Grand Canyon International Hostel**), but there are several others within walking distance.

If you zoom in on this map (http://www.tripadvisor.com/Hotels-g60971-Flagstaff_Arizona-Hotels.html#MAPVIEW) you will see several places that you could walk to downtown from. Of course “walking distance” can mean different things to different people, so be sure to pay attention to the scale in the lower right hand corner.

SOUTH OF TOWN

If you want to stay closer to a department store (WalMart) and grocery, as well as some of the “chain” restaurants (Olive Garden, Red Lobster, I-Hop), you may want to look in the area south of town near the interchange of the Interstate Highways (I-17 & I-40 – Exit 340). This area is about 2.5 miles from downtown and you would likely want to take a taxi if you wanted to hit a pub or coffee house.

EAST OF TOWN

If you want to stay closer to REO, there are several options that are close to the Flagstaff Mall that has a variety of department stores. There are a few restaurants and grocery stores nearby. It's about 4 miles, or a 12 minute drive, from the downtown area and pubs or coffee houses.

Vacation Rentals By Owner (VRBO) and Airbnb

Many people in Flagstaff offer their second homes for rent on a nightly basis. We personally have no experience with these rentals so we can't vouch for them, but some groups like to have their whole group together in one house. Most do require 2-3 night minimum rental and several of them also have cleaning fees that add to the price. However, even with the minimum night rental and cleaning fees, these may end up being cheaper than a hotel. If they do not offer parking while you are on the River, we have a secure lot where you can store your vehicles for \$2 per day per vehicle.
