Each participant must have a serviceable U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation device (PFD) Type I, III or V.

One extra PFD must be carried for every 10 persons on the trip.

On unsupported kayak or canoe trips, one extra PFD is required for every 4 kayaks and/or canoes.

A throwable cushion (USCG approved Type IV) is required for each watercraft 16 feet in length and over.
